Problem Indicators: Pain throughout the body ;
polyarthritits; pain along one half or one quarter
of the body; down one or both arms or legs.
Knee or / and hip pain. Sciatica. Frozen shoulder.
One leg shorter than the other. Height reduction.
Constipation; colitis; irritable bowel syndrome;
Remedies:

- (R) SYMPHYTUM & LYCOPODIUM
- (L) HYDRASTIS & URTICA URENS
